

Know where your water shut off valve is?

In the event of an emergency or if you need to do home repairs you should know where the water shut off valve is to your home. Older homes may not have had one installed when they were first built so it is a good idea to have one installed.



The water meter valve is the property of Lakewood Water District.

If you do not have your own shut off valve, Lakewood

Water District is available to turn your water off at the District owned meter 24hr a day. The cost is \$2 M-F 8 AM—4:30 PM, and \$5 after hours. This fee covers the round trip to turn your water off then back on when you are ready.

Rates

Lakewood Water District reads every meter in the District once every 2 months. Accounts are then billed within 10 days of that meter reading.

Payments are due 25 days from the billing date on the statement.

Rates:

0–800 cubic feet \$16.55 base fee

900–2000 cubic feet \$.85 per 100

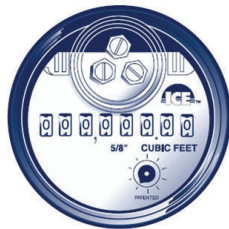
Plus base fee

2000 and over cubic feet \$1.15 per 100

Plus base fee

(100 cubic feet equals 748 gallons)

Payment Options:

Payments can be made several ways:

- Mail
- In person at our office
- Drop box in our parking lot and walk up
- Visa / MasterCard
- Automatic withdrawal (ACH)
- On line through our web site www.lakewood-water-dist.org



Payment Policy

Payment is due 25 days from the billing date on the statement.

Payments are late on the 26th day.

One delinquent notice will be mailed out including a cut off date.

Past due accounts that reach their cut off date will be charged a \$10 Administrative Delinquent Fee.

If a service order is generated to disconnect service, a \$40 Dispatch Fee will be charged.

Deposits:

Deposits are required for tenant accounts only.

The deposit amount is \$50.

Deposit is refunded when the account is closed.

We can also attach an owner's account to their tenants account. In the event the tenant becomes delinquent the owner will be notified.
